



On May 10th The patient presented with localized gingival pain. Following a comprehensive clinical examination, pulp vitality testing, and periapical radiographic evaluation, tooth #19 was diagnosed as non-vital. Root canal therapy was recommended.

The patient opted for an emergency endodontic intervention to relieve pain. An access cavity was prepared, the canals were located and negotiated, and a pulpectomy was performed. The tooth was then sealed with temporary restoration.

Follow-up visit:

13th May 2025, The patient presented for follow-up and reported being completely pain-free. A post-operative periapical radiograph was taken, confirming resolution of acute symptoms with no radiographic signs of active pathology. An interim restoration using glass ionomer cement (GIC) was placed to seal the access cavity. The patient was clearly informed about the status and the importance of completing root canal treatment but has elected not to proceed with further endodontic care at this time.
