**Reason for Visit:**

Routine dental examination conducted in view of planned relocation to another country. Both clinical and radiological evaluations were completed.

**Clinical & Radiological Findings:**

- Dentition Status:

The patient is currently in mixed dentition phase.

- Permanent Teeth:
- Caries observed in all four first permanent molars:
- Tooth numbers 3, 14, 19, and 30
- Primary Teeth:
- Secondary caries and broken restorations noted in:
- Tooth numbers J and K

• Tooth A is covered with a stainless steel crown and has been previously treated with pulpectomy. No active pathology observed in relation to this tooth.

- Oral Hygiene:

Mild plaque accumulation present. Gingiva within normal limits.

**Treatment Plan and Recommendations:****1. Restorative Care:**

- Restoration of permanent molars (tooth numbers 3, 14, 19, and 30).
- Restoration of deciduous teeth J and K.

**2. Preventive Management:**

- Oral Prophylaxis (Scaling and Polishing) to remove plaque deposits.
- Topical Fluoride Application to strengthen enamel and aid in caries prevention.

**3. Follow-Up:**

- Routine dental visits every 6 months recommended post-relocation to ensure continuity of care and monitor oral health status.

**Prognosis:**

Good. With appropriate restorative and preventive care, the patient's oral health can be maintained during the transition phase and beyond.
